### ORDER

As recommended by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Thiruvananthapuram in the letter read as 4th paper above, Government are pleased to modify the Rules for the Kerala State Co-operative Commission Agents Welfare Schemes 2001, as follows.

Those students who intend to apply for the cash award shall submit their application in the prescribed form shown in form No. C-9 along with the true copy of the mark list of SSLC certificate duly attested by the concerned Head Master/Headmistress of the school in which he/she has studied and forward the same to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Kerala State Co-operative Employees Welfare Board, duly recommended by the concerned President and Secretary and two Board of Directors of the Institution within thirty days from the date of publication of the SSLC results.

> Those students who intend to apply for the cash award shall submit their applications in the prescribed. form shown in form C-9 along with the true copy of the mark list and certificate duly attested by Master/ concerned Head Headmistress/Principal in which he/she studied, and forward the same to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Kerala State Co-operative Employees Welfare Board duly recommended by the concerned Head of Department / District / Taluk level officer of the concerned administrative department within thirty days from the date of publication of the results.
