As recommended by the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Thiruvananthapuram in the letter read as 8<sup>th</sup> paper above, Government are pleased to modify the existing Rules for the Constitution and Administration of the Kerala State Co-operative Employees Welfare Board as follows for the purpose of unification of financial assistance to its members, being Permanent employees and Commission Agent/Salesman working in Co-operative Institutions.

'Employee' means an employee of a Co-operative Society registered or deemed to be registered or an institution constituted or established under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969 (Act 21 of 1969) and coming under the administrative control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies and other	'Employee' means a regular employee or a person working on commission basis of a Co-operative Society registered or deemed to be registered or an institution constituted or established under the Kerala Co-operative Societies Act 1969 (Act 21 of 1969) and coming under the administrative control of the Registrar of Co-operative Societies.

Since the amendment as above is issued for the purpose of unification of financial assistance to its members, being Permanent employees and Commission Agent/Salesman working in Co-operative Institutions, the Kerala State Co-operative Commission Agents Welfare Scheme 2001 issued vide Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above is here by cancelled.
