ORDER

Government, as per the G.O. read as first paper above, issued the Rules for the constitution and administration of the Kerala Co-operative Employees' Welfare Fund. The Managing Committee of the Kerala Co-operative Employees' Welfare Fund has decided to change the name of the "Kerala Co-operative Employees' Welfare Fund" as the "Kerala State Co-operative Employees' Welfare Board". The Managing Committee has also resolved to incorporate other amendments also with a view to enhancing the field of activities of the Institution for the betterment of the welfare of the employees who opt to come over to the scheme. The Registrar of Co-operative Societies has recommended the proposed amendments and requested Government to suitably amend the Rules.

2) After having considered the proposals received from the Registran of Co-operative Societies. Government are pleased to issue the following amendments to the Rules issued in G.O(Rt) 333/86/Co-opedated 30.9.1986 viz

AMENDMENTS.

- 1. The "KERALA CO-OPERATIVE EMPLOYEES'WELFARE FUND' shall here in after be known as the "KERALA STATE CO-OPERATIVE EMPLOYEES' WELFARE BOARD".
- 2. The title of the Rules given in rule 1 of the Rules issued in G.O(Rt)383/86/Co-op: dated 30.9.1996 shall be corrected and read as follows:
 - 1. Title: -These rules shall be called the Rules for the constitution and Administration of the Kerala State Cooperative Employees' Welfare Board.
- 3. In the subsequent rules, the word' Fund' wherever occurs to indicate the name of the Institution, shall be substituted by the word 'Board'.

- 4. Rule4. shall be substituted by the following: -
- 4. Management: -The management and administration of the Board shall vest with a managing committee consisting of the following persons-
- a) Minister in charge of co-operation (Chairman Ex-officio)
- b) Secretary (co-operation) to Government of Kerala.
- c) Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Trivandrum.
 d) Chairman, Kerala State Co-operative Union, Trivandrum.
- e) Joint or Deputy Secretary to Government,
 Finance Department (to be nominated by the Government of Kerala)
- f) Two representatives of Associations of Co-operative Employees (to be nominated by the Government of Kerala)
- g) Five persons who are associated with the co-operative movement to be nominated by the Government of Kerala.
- h) Secretary-Treasurer of the Board to be appointed by the Government.
- 2) Secretary-Treasurer of the Board shall be an officer in the cadre of an Additional Registrar of Co-operative Societies appointed by Government.
 - 3) There shall be a Vice-Chairman for the Board. The Vice-Chairman shall be nominated by Government of Kerala from among the members of the managing committee of the Kerala State Co-operative Employees' Welfare Board.
- 5. In rule 5 of the Rules, the word "five" shall be substituted by the word 'seven".
- 6. Sub-rule(b)below rule 19 of the Rules shall be substituted by the following:-
 - (b) Every employee who has exercised his/her option to come over to the scheme to enjoy the benefit under the rules shall pay a monthly contribution of Rs 20/-(Rupees twenty only) to the Board from the date on which he/she joins the Scheme.
 - 7. Sub-rul: (c)below rule 19 shall be deleated: and the existing sub-rule(d) renumbered as(c):
 - 8. Sub-rul: (a) below rule 26 shall be substituted by the following:-
 - (1) If an employee coming under sub-rule(b) of rule
 19 dies while in service an amount of Rs 30000/(Rupees Thirty Thousand only) shall be paid to
 his/her family.
 - 9. Sub-rule(b)below rule 26 shall be deleted and the ramaining sub-rules renumbered as(b),(c) and(d) respectively.
 - 10. After sub-rule(d) of rule 26 so renumbered, the following shall be added as sub-rules(e) and (E) viz
 - e) An employee covered by the scheme, who is undergoing tractement for cancer, heart operation and kidney transplantation shall be given of Rs 10000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand only) as grant.

For financial assistance under this scheme an application in the Form prescribed in Annexure VIII shall be submitted through the President of the Institution to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Kerala State Co-operative Employees' Welfare Board, duly supported by a Medical Certificate, in original, issued by a Medical Officer not below the rank of an Associate Professor of Medical Colleges/Notified Medical Institutions. The application shall be countersigned by the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societics (General) of the Taluk under whose jurisdiction the applicant's Institution is situated.

f) At State Level children of the employees coming under rule 19(b) of the Rules, who secure the first two places in the S.S.L.C Examination in every academic year shall be given Cash Awards of Rs 2000/-(Rupees two thousand) and Rs 1500/-(Rupees one thousand and five hundred) respectively for the 1st and 2nd places.

Similarly at District Level, one Cash Award of Rs.1000/(Rs one thousand) shall be given in every academic year to
the child of the employee coming under rule 19(b) of the Rules
who secure the highest marks in the S.S.L.C examination in
the District.

Those students who intend to apply for the Cash Award shall submit their applications in the prescribed Form shown in Innexure IX along with the true copy of the markelist of S.S.L.C Certificate duly attested by the concerned Headmaster/Headmistress of the school in which he/she has studied and forward the same to the Secretary/Treasurer of the Kerala State Co-operative Employees' Welfare Board, duly recommended by the Assistant Registrar of Co-operative Societies (General) of the concerned Administrative Department within Thirty days from date of publication of the S.S.LC results.

11. The subrules(e) and (f) below rule 26 will be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1.7.1992.
